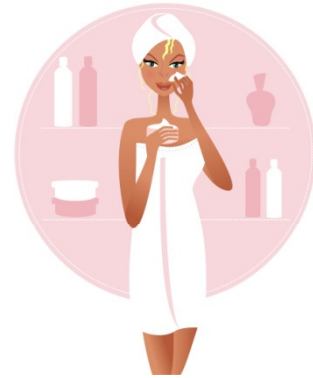
Alison Jones is already an RDA Group Instructor and Jennifer Bonser, Nicola Bromley and Lynne McKissick are RDA Log Book Holders.

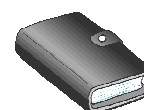
